



Important Dates for Students

- Complete the UA Early College (UAEC) application **and** ask your counselor to submit your high school transcript to UAEC by **Tuesday, October 13, 2026, at 4:45 p.m.** You must be a current junior in high school with a 3.5+ cumulative GPA.
- Complete the Teach in Bama online application and references by **Tuesday, October 13, 2026, at 4:45 p.m.**
- UAEC 200 College Readiness Course Overview is currently scheduled for Tuesday, October 27, 2026.
 - Student and parent participation is required for the online session, Tuesday, October 13, 6:30 p.m. – 8:30 p.m.
- Complete UAEC 200
 - All students must pass UAEC 200 to be eligible for further participation in UAEC courses and the Teach in Bama program
- Sign up for Spring 2027 Course
 - A UAEC academic advisor will provide you with a list of specific courses and help you decide what classes to take. Classes begin January 13, 2027
 - All students must pass this course with a 3.0 (B) to be eligible for further participation in the Teach in Bama program
- Sign up for the 5-week UAEC Summer on Campus: Summer I Term, 2027.
 - Immerse yourself in the college experience, taking courses while living on the picturesque University of Alabama campus. Earn 6-7 college credits
 - All students must pass these courses with a GPA of a 3.0 (B) to be eligible for further participation in the Teach in Bama program
 - Application expected to open late February
- Participate in Teach in Bama Summer Institute (runs concurrently with UAEC Summer on Campus) 2027.
 - This program will consist of sessions curated to support and expose students to resources that will aid them throughout their teacher preparation program
 - All students must pass these courses with a GPA of a 3.0 (B) to be eligible for further participation in the Teach in Bama program
- Sign up for Fall 2027 Course
 - A UAEC academic advisor will provide you with a list of specific courses and help you decide what classes to take. Classes begin August 18, 2027
 - All students must pass this course with a GPA of a 3.0 (B) to be eligible for further participation in the Teach in Bama program
- Apply for admission to the University of Alabama by December 2027, application opens August 1st.

- Teach in Bama Scholarship notification expected March 2028
